global thinker public intellectual and world famous theorist of liquid modernity zygmunt bauman 1925 2017 was a scholar who despite forced migration built a very successful academic career and after retirement became a prolific and popular writer and an intellectual talisman for young people everywhere he was one of those rare scholars who grey haired and in his eighties had his finger on the pulse of the youth this is the first comprehensive biography of bauman s life and work izabela wagner returns to bauman s native poland and recounts his childhood in an assimilated polish jewish family and the school experiences shaped by anti semitism bauman s life trajectory is typical of his generation and social group the escape from nazi occupation and
